

Since My Divorce Writer's Guidelines

I am happy to accept guest posts and you should [submit your proposal](#) to me before sending an actual post. There is no payment for guest posts. Guest posts generally fall into two categories:

- Your own personal story about your life post-divorce
- A specific topic relevant to divorce and life after divorce. These can cover a broad range including aspects of the legal process, parenting, healing, financial, living singly or dating, for example.

Your proposal should state specifically the topic you would like to cover including a working title and a brief content description. Please tell me a little about yourself, why you're interested in guest posting and also what you would be able to do to help promote your post.

Format

- Posts should be about 750 to 1000 words in length. If your topic requires more, then the post can be split into two or even several.
- Include links to relevant resources. A general guideline is one link for every 120-150 words.
- Your writing needs to be technically and grammatically correct. I have higher expectations if you are writing as a subject-matter expert than if you are submitting your personal story.
- I like my posts to include an image and it helps enormously if you can provide this. Images need to be copyright free and correctly attributed.

Content

- I understand that the material you submit to me may have been published already elsewhere or that you may be hoping to publish it elsewhere and I ask you to disclose that up front. I do ask however, that you give me your best assurance that it won't be published elsewhere within 30 days before or after the anticipated posting date on my site.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that no one else holds the publication rights to the material so please be careful if the material has already been published.

Bio

- Include a short bio about yourself. This may include a link back to your own website, your Facebook page and your Twitter page. If you are publishing your own story and are concerned about your privacy, I recommend using a pseudonym.

Publication/Promotion

- Once you have submitted your post, I will give you an estimated publication date. I will also contact you immediately prior to publication to let you know the actual date.
- Any help you can lend to promote your post via Facebook and/or Twitter will help us both and I appreciate it.
